Reference your memo of November 10th. I have not seen the marginally noted man as yet this morning 'though I understand the D. D. M. S. saw him before I came in. I am not aware of what decision he came to but Major Paterson is a member of the Board which recommended his admission to Jensen Camp.

The man has active disease and it has been the custom of the Medical Board to retain such men on the strength in order that they may be under discipline.

If this man is discharged in order to take up his former employment he cannot carry out the recommendation of the Board to "take complete rest". His pension will be considerably less than "Total" and ultimately he will become a charge on the pension fund with complete disability; he will then of necessity enter Jensen Camp having in the meanwhile thrown away what chances he had of a cure. The man has been steadily losing ground since last Board.

My own feeling in the matter is that this man should be ordered to report at once at Jensen Camp.

Reference your communication of 10th inst., relative marginally named soldier. I have had this soldier before me, and he feels that if he went to Jensen Camp, he would only become depressed, and that his state of mind would be such that no real benefit would accrue.

In this connection, I would refer the report of Major Patterson S.M.O. dated July 14, 1917, copy of which was forwarded to you August 24th, 1917.

Pte. Woods informs me that Dr. Anderson, with whom he was formerly employed, wishes him to go back to him, if he is not fit for the Regiment, and that he would like to get his discharge..

I informed him of the recommendation of the Medical Board, and suggested to him that he see Major Patterson who is fully aware of the circumstances of the case, and that he report to you on Monday morning when he will place his position before you, and you will advise him as to his position in the circumstances.

## Descriptive Return of a Soldier Discharged on Account of Disability
