## Descriptive Return of a Soldier Discharged on Account of Disability.

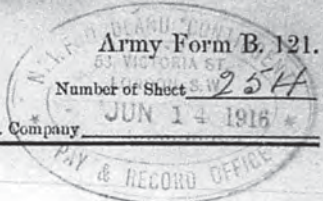

The method of wearing the ribbons of Orders, Decorations and Medals, which will be the same in all cases, both for men and women, is as follows:

A piece of the ribbon one and a half inches wide, or the width of the medal ribbon, and half an inch in depth, mounted on a bar of metal in the form of a brooch, to be worn on the left breast of the coat, or in a

Decorations and Medals with morning dress on Official Occasions and at Public Functions.

The Ribbons of the Orders, Decorations and Medals may be worn on all occasions at the discretion of the holder.

The method of wearing the Insignia of Orders, also Decorations and Medals, on Official Occasions and at Public Functions with morning dress is as follows:-

( Should wear the Star only on the left breast of the Coat or in a corresponding place on the dress, as the case may be.

( Should wear the ribbon to which Badge is suspended under the tie, which should be above; the badge hanging about three-quarters of an inch below the Bow.

( Should wear the Badges, Decorations and Medals on the left breast of the coat, or in a corresponding place on the dress as the case may be.

NOTE:- The above intimation only refers to Morning Dress and does not alter the regulations with regard to wearing Orders, Decorations and Medals with Uniform, or with Evening Dress.

(Extract from the London Gazette, No. 31624, 31 October, 1919)

## Occasions and Method of Wearing Decorations.

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As the regulations for wearing of Orders and Decorations issued by the Lord Chamberlain's Department are not too well known; the following directions are issued for the information and guidance of those persons in Newfoundland who have been honoured with decorations by His Majesty.

They contain some small modifications to suit local convenience, since it is recognised by His Majesty the King that local modifications are in some cases desirable.

- I. - Full-sized decorations are always worn with (full-dress) uniform.

Undress uniform, as a rule, carries ribbons, and not the full decoration or medal itself. And for this purpose field service dress (khaki) is accepted as undress.

It is appointed, however, that in Newfoundland, on a full dress occasion such as the opening of the Legislature, etc., an officer entitled to decoration may wear the full-sized decoration, notwithstanding that his uniform is khaki. This would, as a rule, be mentioned on the notice or invitation.

- II. - Decorations are not worn with morning dress, i.e., frock coat or morning coat. :#:

- III. - Decorations should be worn with evening dress on the following occasions:

- (a) At any dinner, reception, or other evening function at Government House, unless special orders are issued to the contrary.
- (b) At any distinctly official dinner or reception in the evening.
- (c) At any function in the evening, whether at a private house or public hall at which it is intimated that the Governor, as such, will be present.

It is hardly necessary to say that the rule for the above occasions is intended to be a mark of respect to the King, whom the Governor represents.

- IV. - The badges of a Knight Commander of any Order, of Companion of the Bath, and Companion of St. Michael and St. George, or of the Commander of any Order (e.g., the Order of the British Empire), are worn round the neck (under the white tie in evening dress) and so as to fall an inch below the collar.

- V. - On those Orders or grades where the decoration is not worn round the neck, it is the rule in the United Kingdom that only a miniature decoration should be worn on the lapel of the evening coat; but, following a practice which is convenient outside the United Kingdom, special license is given in Newfoundland to wear the full-sized decoration either on the lapel of the evening coat or on the left side of the coat.

- VI. - As regards the Order of the British Empire only:

only

- (a) Ladies should wear the full-sized decoration on all occasions, as indicated in III, above.
- (b) As regards gentlemen, - it has apparently not yet been decided whether there will be any miniature of the decoration of Officer and Member; but, in any case, license is given in Newfoundland to wear the full-sized decoration on all occasions indicated in III above.
