The Applicant in the case of Pte. Allan S. Young, Newfoundland Regiment, No. 1286 who volunteered for the Service in March 8/15 is his Aunt. His (Pte. A.S. Young) mother died about 20 years ago, leaving four children aged as follows:

. Annah aged 9 years. Allan S., 6. Olive 4. Augustus 2 years, Isabel 7 months,

About four years latter the Father died. The applicant Miss Dorcas Clark, devoted herself and her energies to the support and care of the family.

Two of the children were of a very delicate constitution, one a girl, Olive, died about a year ago, Augustus who is suffering from a Tubercular head, is also of a rather delicate nature, and at times is incapacitated from work of any kind.

When Private Allan S. Young volunteered, he was the only support of the family, and was contributing at that time, between \$500 & \$600 annually towards the support of his brother and sisters. and his Aunt who is caring for the family. Again the amount received by the Applicant from the Government, during the four years service of Private Young. \$15.00 per month did in no way support the family dependant upon him, in such comfortable circumstances, as they would have been if Pte.
